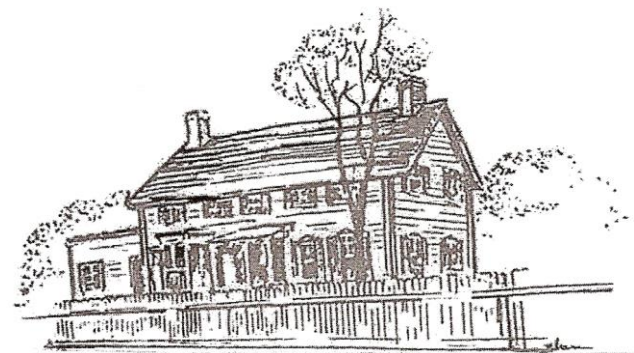

As we come to the conclusion of the Society's 25th year, we can be thankful for the many positive aspects of the year. Our Board of Trustees approved the heating and air conditioning system, the front fence, and the roof of the shed. The fence and the roof projects are yet to be undertaken, although the contracts have been issued.

The Society was recognized in May by the Chamber of Commerce and B.I.D. as the Distinguished Citizen of the Year along with Priscilla and myself. The Bay Shore Historical Society was the first organization to be named for this prestigious honor in Bay Shore. Our grateful thanks go to the Chamber and B.I.D..

We were recently notified by Robert Finnegan, Islip Town Historian, that the Society would be further honored by receiving the Town of Islip's Treadwell Scudder/ Benajah Strong History Award (Supervisor's Award) for the Outstanding Historical Society. This award was presented to the Society on November 16, 2010 at the Town Hall in a ceremony and reception. Congratulations, members!

During the past year the Society's monthly programs were well received by our members and community residents. In July we celebrated our 25th anniversary at a dinner at Captain Bill's with recognition of 25 members who are still active from the 134 original founding members in 1985. Seven of these charter members from 25 years ago still volunteer at the Gibson-Mack-Holt House and were presented with "outstanding volunteer" pins. The past presidents and the faithful weekly volunteers who were not charter members received "volunteer" pins of recognition for their dedicated service to the Society.

I wish to thank all the former and present officers, trustees, and volunteer members and supporters who have helped the Society prosper these 25 years.

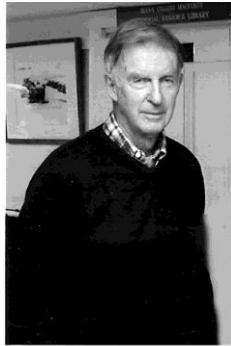
