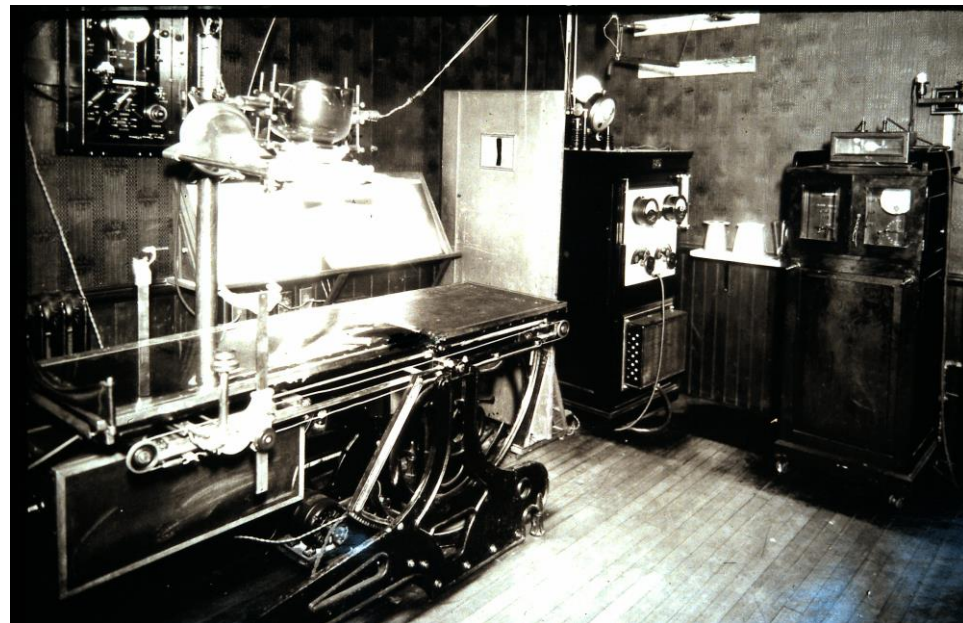

The Basement has undergone a revitalization. Over one hundred historical photographs of Bay Shore are now on display and have been labeled and catalogued thanks to Mimi's grandchildren. Two new display cases, dedicated to Robert "Jake" Jacobsen, contain numerous Bay Shore artifacts and memorabilia. Original Thurber drawings of Bay Shore's Main Street in the 1880's are on display on top of the cabinet. It is fascinating to look at the drawings and envision life in our hamlet one hundred and thirty years ago.

Our monthly meetings (the third Thursday of every month except for July and December) have been well attended. The speakers have been informative and the refreshments afterward (thank you JoAnn, Carol, Mimi, et al) provide a time for socialization.
