

April 20, 2017 Bay Shore Historical Society Meeting Notes

Barry called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM and all recited the Pledge of Allegiance. There was a moment of silence to remember Julia Perino. Phil thanked everyone for sending cards and attending services. Kelly read the minutes of the March 16, 2017 meeting. Priscilla reported on the last Summit Counsel Meeting. (1) The Bay Shore High School is the Regional Champions of this year's Mock Trial Tournament. (2) Contributions are needed to purchase the hanging flower baskets hung throughout the community. The cost per basket is \$45. (3) Greg Probst named Distinguished Citizen and will be honored at dinner on May 19 at Captain Bills. It is Greg who puts up and takes down the hanging flower baskets. (4) The annual Beautification Society luncheon is June 22 at Captain Bills. This year's theme is 'Magic on the Bay'. (5) There is a meeting on April 26 for the Heartland Project. This is the last meeting scheduled before the formal vote on the Project. JoAnn reported membership is at 250. Joe reported income was \$1,683 and expenses were \$1,730.

The speaker for the evening was Judy Pedneault, the President of the Bohemia Historical Society. Bohemia was established in 1855. The town was founded by 3 families from Czechoslovakia. The Bohemia Historical Society received a grant from the Gardiner Foundation to produce an educational video. Judy showed this video called 'Bohemia Then and Now'. After the video, Judy mentioned that the Bohemia Historical Society has 3 published books. Judy had copies of the cookbook with her for sale.
